This senior leadership role will provide expertise and support to NICS, specifically the NICS Medical Director, in developing relationships and ways of working with system partners across North West Surrey. Initially a key focus of this role will be to support the transition, mobilisation and development of services to users who have unscheduled and urgent care needs with minor injuries and illnesses as part of NICS' partnership to manage, on behalf of Ashford & St Peter's Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, the Urgent Treatment Centre (UTC) based at St. Peter's Hospital.

The successful candidate should be a registered General Practitioner and would require excellent interpersonal and communication skills and demonstrate high levels of organisational and management expertise. Individuals should have prior experience of clinically working and managing within an urgent care setting with an expectation that the Clinical Director, alongside the 16 hours of non-clinical work, will undertake a minimum of 16 hours clinical time per week within the UTC to compliment this role.
