- Consent from parents (unless places yourself or child at risk)
- Child/children safe and whereabouts
- Names and DOB of child/children
- Safeguarding Concerns
- Details of the parents

GP HOT CLINIC ADULT SAFEGUARDING PATHWAY

Adult safeguarding duties apply to ANY adult who:

- Has care and support needs
- Is experiencing, or is at risk of, abuse or neglect
- Is unable to protect themselves because of their care and support needs



Is the patient, or contacts including children, other adults or public at risk of immediate harm?

If children are involved contact child social services (see Children Safeguarding Pathway)



YES

- Contact police if emergency or if criminal activity
- Contact Social Services (contact details below)
- Appropriately record all information in notes



NO

- Ensure vulnerable person and any other adults involved are safe
- Consider contacting Social Services (contact details below)
- Appropriately record all information in notes
